Lekòl Sen Trinite: The seeds of knowledge are sown in this tuition-free institution, spanning from preschool to 9th grade. But our commitment goes beyond academics—arts education and other programs enrich the lives of our students, nurturing creativity and expression.

SJ Community Outreach Center: Offering a haven from the chaos on the streets of Port-au-Prince, the SJ Community Outreach Center offers a safe place for the community to gather for meetings and worship. The SJCOC also allows students to be enriched through dance classes and recreation offered at the facility. A neighborhood school rents space in the facility to educate the young people in the neighborhood.

From his days as a young resident at St. Joseph's Home for Boys to becoming the director of Wings of Hope in 2010, he's witnessed the transformative power of this sanctuary. He's overseeing the residents' wellbeing with unwavering dedication.

"Wings is a home that cares," Jacky said. "When you enter into the home, no matter the abilities you have, we welcome you as a brother, as a sister."

As a product of the St. Joseph Family himself, Gephte's journey from a community member to a lead teacher is a testament to the profound sense of purpose that Wings of Hope ignites. For both Gephte and Jacky, Wings of Hope extends far beyond job descriptions; it has become a calling, a way of life.

Each resident is treated not as a charge, but as a beloved family member. Wings of Hope isn't merely a residence; it's a true home, a safe haven where people's lives are transformed.

Empowering Through Unity:

Together, we have crafted a nurturing haven for those grappling with the intersection of poverty and disability at Wings of Hope. This sanctuary embraces not just the physical needs but also the emotional and educational aspirations of its residents, fostering a true sense of belonging.



BY THE NUMBERS:

- Capacity for up to 40 residents
- Each resident receives care based solely on individual needs
- 6 staff members live at the home
- Nights of shelter provided (2022): 12,045
- Meals for residents & live-in staff: 42,705
- Comprehensive medical check-ups & medicine (needed as a result of exams) \$4.800
- Current sponsorship rate (to cover annual cost per resident)= 34.4%



Per resident annual cost (33 residents in 2022): \$6,690

These vital materials were procured in Haiti itself, a testament to the transformative power of local support.

Adding an extra touch of kindness, each student was presented with a brand-new backpack, courtesy of one of our dedicated church partners. This thoughtful gesture not only lightened their load but also symbolized the unwavering support they have from a broader community that believes in their potential.

A Collaborative Effort

Hearts with Haiti seized a unique opportunity to join forces with Love Takes Root to share a shipping container destined for Haiti in July 2022. With swiftness and dedication, we launched a collaborative effort to swiftly gather essential supplies for the journey. Among the pressing needs were waterproof mattresses and wheelchairs for the residents of Wings of Hope—a crucial requirement unavailable for purchase within Haiti.

The response was heartwarming. Generosity flowed as 40 waterproof mattresses and 26 wheelchairs were donated, addressing immediate needs that would significantly impact the lives of



those at Wings of Hope. But the outpouring of support didn't end there.

Hundreds of articles of clothing, diapers, household items, physical therapy supplies, healthcare essentials, art supplies, chairs, and an array of other items also were contributed. Wings of Hope was able to share surplus wheelchairs and clothing items with local community members.

Despite unforeseen delays, the container arrived in late November, a timely Christmas gift for the St. Joseph Family. We extend our gratitude to all who contributed, whether through purchases from the SJF wish list on Amazon.com or through other generous donations. The impact of this collaborative effort extends far beyond the physical items shipped; it's a demonstration of solidarity, compassion, and the enduring drive which exemplifies the commitment to the St. Joseph Family.





Enrichment Through the Arts

The students at Lekòl Sen Trinite and Wings of Hope are fortunate to go beyond their basic academic classes and also get a rich education in the arts—dance, drumming, music, and painting.

This is all due to our long partnership with our friends at Broadway for Arts Education (BAE). BAE provides teachers' salaries and art and music supplies for the classes. The students perform in exhibitions and celebrations, and their paintings are available for exposition and purchase.

An education in the arts provides enrichment and talent development, and also allows the students to develop self-esteem and to increase their pride in their country and culture.

Responding to Emerging Needs

Water, food and provisions are in short supply and the costs rise daily. Movement throughout Haiti is restricted because of the threat of gang violence and protests. Governmental safety nets such as Medicaid and other assistance programs are absent, so the impact of foreign non-profits like Hearts with Haiti cannot be overstated.

Amidst the daunting challenges posed by political turmoil, gang activity, and economic instability, the resilience of the Haitian people continues to shine. The unyielding dedication of the St Joseph Family's leaders and employees is admirable, even in the face of escalating prices, daily violence, and relentless uncertainty.

Propane + 33% \$240 to \$320 per month


Diapers +114% \$844 to \$1,806 per month
